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Raksha Bandhan Celebration at Mount Litera Zee School Porbandar: The Bond of Protection and Love

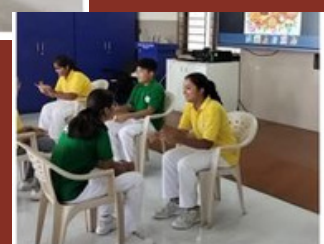

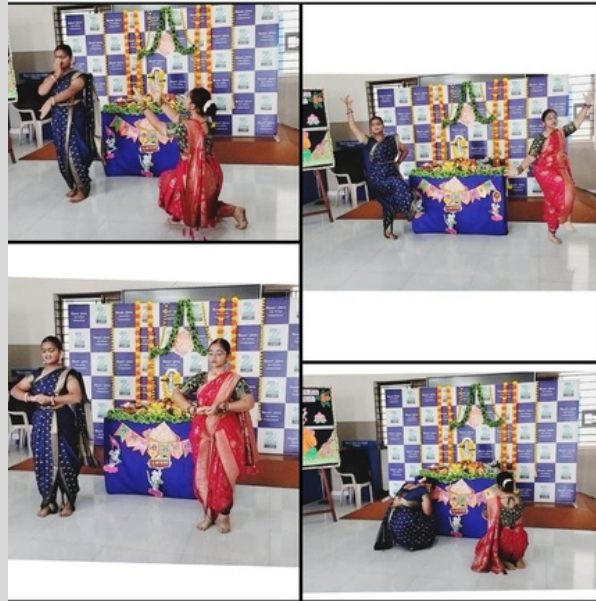
The celebration kicked off with a heartfelt Arti, performed by students.. The students' participation in this ritual demonstrated their respect and reverence for the traditions associated with the festival.

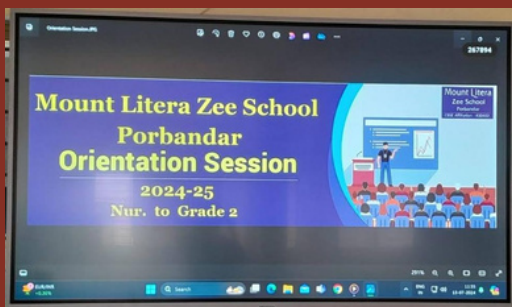

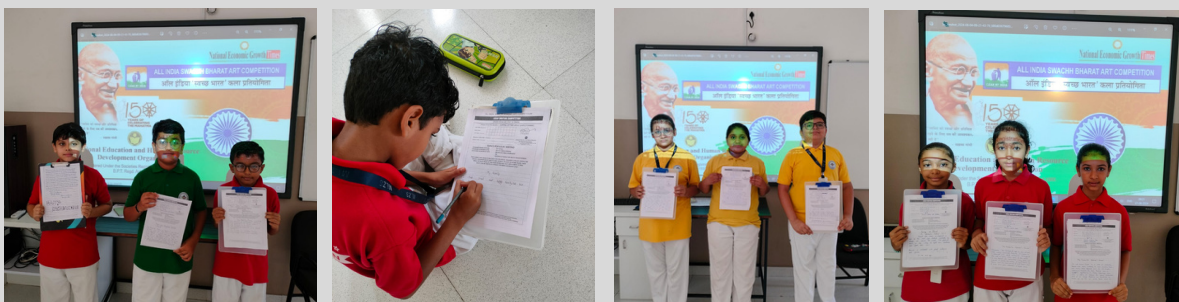
Day 1 : (05/08/24): The event kicked off with a general assembly where students showcased their artistic ideas on Swachh Bharat through drawings.

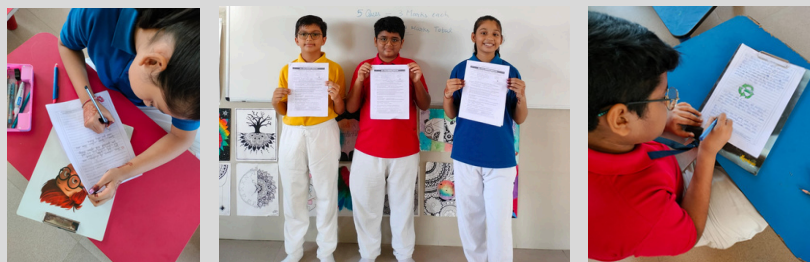
Day 4 : (08/08/24): An Art and Craft competition for Grades 1 to 7 was organized, where students crafted items promoting the Swachh Bharat theme.
